

STFC Ernest Rutherford Fellowship applications with the RAL Particle Physics Department

As part of the UK's national laboratories, STFC's Particle Physics Department constructs, operates and scientifically exploits the world's most advanced particle accelerators and particle physics experiments. Alongside the construction and upgrade of current machines (HL-LHC, PIP-II) and experiments (ATLAS, CMS, LHCb, DUNE, Hyper-K, LZ, AION), we are starting to plan R&D towards new international facilities.

For the 2021 call for applications for the STFC Ernest Rutherford Fellowship we seek particle physicists, accelerator physicists and computing experts to propose their projects. The five-year fellowship is highly competitive and up to ten are awarded in support of early career researchers that do not hold a permanent position.
